One of the passages that I learned early in life is from Philippians 4. *Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice.* And, a few verses later it says: *And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.*

This is how Eugene Peterson paraphrases verse 4-7 in *The Message*:

**Celebrate God all day, every day. I mean, revel in him! Make it as clear as you can to all you meet that you're on their side, working with them and not against them. Help them see that the Master is about to arrive. He could show up any minute! Don't fret or worry. Instead of worrying, pray. Let petitions and praises shape your worries into prayers, letting God know your concern. Before you know it, a sense of God's wholeness, everything coming together for good, will come and settle you down. It's wonderful what happens when Christ displaces worry at the center of your life.**

What a wonderful way of thinking about each day. Whether it is celebrating or turning our concerns over to God. Shaping our worries into prayer and trusting that God's wholeness will come and settle us down. I must admit that some days are easier than others. This is especially true when the sun is shining but I have to be careful to not let blips in my schedule or other inconveniences interrupt or derail the whole day.

I'm wondering what are the things/activities that you do every day that celebrates God? Are you a thinker or more of a doer? I know that some of you love to read, some are writers. Some of you are gardeners, builders, sewers, bakers. Some of you are connectors and love to be involved in lots of activities while that is too tiring for others. I'm all about finding balance in life and connecting our worship together with the other 167 hours we have each week.

Yes, embrace the gift of each day and celebrate. And, when worries abound shape them into prayer. I wonder what it will be like when all of us sense God's wholeness and let God settle us down. Let's do it. Let's live it!
